Expect excellence from yourself and from others.

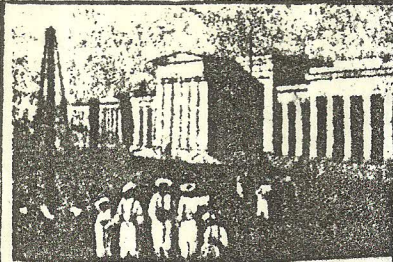
SOME NEWS ITEMS
